Animal cards

If you have 3 Turtles: move 3 spaces.

If you have 3 Penguins: move 5 spaces.

If you have 3 Tigers: move 7 spaces.

If you have one of each: move 2 spaces.

A card with all 3 animals can be used as an animal of choice.

*

If there's a player on the space where you're supposed to land, move up to the next free space available. You can playmultiple sets of cards in one turn.

Special animal cards

If you play an Elephant card, you can pick a card from another player without looking.

If you play a Giraffe card, you can view the cards of one of your fellow players and then pick one.

At the end of your turn, you can only have 4 cards in your hand. If you have more than 4 cards, you have to discard the extra card(s) back to the bottom of the deck.

The winner

After 8 rounds, the player that's in first place wins!

Photo cards

If you don't have access to internet, play the game with the photo cards. Take 8 cards and put them face up (questions down) on the table. Each round, one player (starting with the oldest player) is the quizmaster, who asks but can't answer the questions. The quizmaster will automatically receive 2 cards at the end of each round. In the second round the next oldest player is quizmaster, etcetera.

Answer questions correctly to receive cards and move around the board. The player in first place after 8 rounds wins!

Start

Open the website bbcearthboardgame.com on your laptop, tablet, smartphone or Smart TV. Enter your code that's on the last page of these rules and press start.

Shuffle the animal cards. Each player chooses a colour pawn plus ABC answer discs and receives 2 animal cards.



Place the rest of the animal cards and the chosen pawns on the game board as shown in the picture.



The youngest player places his pawn on position 1, the oldest on the last position (2, 3 or 4 depending on how many people are playing).

Start

Make sure everybody has a good view of the screen and press start.

Round

A round starts with a video: at the end of each video a question will be asked. All the players will answer at the same time by putting their answer card face down on the table.



When the screen shows the answer, each player will reveal his answer. Each player that gave the right answer, will receive an animal card from the deck. Then press next and move on to the next question.

Each round has 3 questions (and 2 videos). At the end of each round, all players receive an extra animal card. Therefore, if you answer all the questions right, you will collect 4 cards in one round and if you have 2 questions right, you get 3 cards etcetera.

The player in last place always goes first. Then it's the players turn that was in second to last place etcetera. At the start of the game, the oldest player goes first.



You start counting spaces from the circle with the arrow. If you reach the last space on the board, just continue into your second round.
